

Set within Farley Farm near Romsey, is a private runway and a collection of old corrugated aircraft hangars. The Farley Hangar build was inspired by its aviation surroundings and designed to seamlessly blend with the neighbouring structures, complimenting the use of the site. The curved black corrugated roof was chosen to match the surrounding buildings and the timber cladding was further stained black to finish the look.
